Private Projects Definitions Highlight = Priority

Proposed Acquisition (Note: All new development projects will be ADA compliant.)

Passive: The purpose of the acquisition would be to create a passive park with views of the water but no access.

Kayak Launch: the site would be developed with a kayak launch.

Additional Facilities: New facilities or uses beyond views and/or a kayak launch.

Pedestrian Access: The project would only be accessed by pedestrians: fishing piers, riverwalks, waterfront parks, overlooks, trails, paths, walkways, etc.

Active: Facilities that allow physical access to the water. Motorized - Boat ramps, docking facilities, mooring buoys, etc. Non-Motorized - Kayak launches, paddleboard launches, rowing center, etc.

Community Context:

Perception of Need: The survey asked respondents about their overall priorities in terms of funding. The percentage supporting the existing facility enhancement or proposed facility type is listed.

Request for Facility Type: The survey asked what enhanced or additional facilities were supported in each waterway district. More than 20 responses is considered significant, between 10 and 19 is considered moderate, under 10

Planning Objective/Source: The citation of a Comprehensive, Vision, Local or other plan that identifies the need for this facility type, or for public water access use of the subject site, or the source of the project in the Maritime

Cost and Leverage:

Estimate of Improvements: Low = less than \$500,000. Medium = between \$500,000 and \$1M. High = more than \$1M. Estimate does not include acquisition cost.

Potential Funding Source: List of eligible grant programs, including Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND), Florida Boating Improvement Program (FBIP) and Boating Infrastructure Grant Program (BIG-P).

Risk:

Useful Life: Structures are assumed to have a useful life of 25 years.

Risk at 2040: Risk of inundation related to projected sea level rise in the year 2040. (For this analysis, the planning team used GIS data for 2040 and 2070 that reflected the "Mean High Water" tidal datum and the "Intermediate" sea level change projection curves. Each existing water access facility was examined individually to assess potential risk from SLR for each of the two decadal scenarios. Based on this assessment, each site was assigned a risk-level described as "No Significant Impact", "Significant Impact", or "Very Significant Impact".) Where access or the site itself is projected to have very significant impact, it is noted on the matrix.

Risk at 2070: Risk of inundation related to projected sea level rise in the year 2070. See above.
